This summer, I am going to produce, in my woodshop, a one-time production run of a high end hockey equipment drying trees. They are handmade (by me) from **Western Red Cedar** and will hold an entire set of adult hockey gear. The unit is finished with a clear coating of polyurethane to ensure it stands up to the task for many years. Felt pads on the feet prevent any marring of a hardwood floor. Your player's initials can even be carved into the top of the tree as well if desired. The Condors logo will appear on the top of the tree and each one is branded with my logo. **These are truly one of a kind racks.**

- The cost of the units will be **\$135** each with **\$25 from each unit being donated to the Condors.**
- I will require a **\$50 deposit** for each one ordered.
- They will be ready to go when the Condors hit the ice this fall.
- I will have one of the units at our closing banquet for closer inspection.

Yes, you can buy a flimsy metal or plastic rack at Canadian Tire for less but you won't find one of this quality and size anywhere, never mind one that is customized for your player **AND** benefits the Condors!
